



PHASE II CLINICAL TRIAL

Help Make Phase II a Reality!

In the United States, most clinical trials are funded by pharmaceutical companies, which have vested interests in bringing a new drug to market. Unfortunately, it's challenging for remarkable therapeutic substances like mistletoe to undergo rigorous study. Only through our collective efforts can we make this a reality. Last year we celebrated the completion of Phase 1. However, there is more to be done. I have been in discussions with Johns Hopkins and researchers in Germany regarding the design of phase 2. BUT, in order to even begin any phase 2 trial, we need to raise \$500,000 of the estimated 1.5 million dollars needed for phase 2. To date we have raised \$117,000 of the \$500,000.

Nutrition + Mistletoe Grants

Through our grant programs, we approved over 400 grants valued at \$107k. These grants were distributed across various key areas: 277 were allocated for consultations, ensuring recipients had access to integrative medical care and support; 102 were specifically for mistletoe IV treatments; 20 focused on nutrition, supporting the health and dietary needs of our beneficiaries; and 1 special grant was awarded to address a unique and critical need.



The problem that most cancer patients are experiencing.

Once diagnosed, patients:

- Are immediately rushed on a conveyor belt of treatment with only three options: chemo, radiation, and surgery.
- Don't realize that their care should be individualized and not standardized.
- Don't think they have time to investigate other options not knowing that it typically takes cancer seven to ten years to grow in the first place.
- Are so overwhelmed with just being diagnosed that they aren't sure of what questions to ask or that there is a better way where they can complement treatments and have a great quality and quantity of life.
- Are trying to figure out how they are going to be able to sustain their family financially.
- Hear the word cancer, and they are instantly filled with fear as the only picture they see in their mind is of someone who is suffering and weak.

STAGE IV COLON CANCER

I was diagnosed with a very aggressive stage IV, Gleason scale 9 out of 10, prostate cancer that had metastasized to my arm. For some of us, that diagnosis brings shock. How in the world could this happen to me? As a follower of Jesus Christ, I knew I needed to first go to him and go to his word.

My wife and I decided to grab a set of verses to carry us through this journey. So we picked Philippians 4 and experienced the promises of these verses. It says, "Don't worry about anything. Instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and your minds as you live in Christ Jesus."

As we pressed into these verses and promises, we began to see God orchestrate through friends and connections a holistic, integrated, world-class care team. Our healing journey began with the wisdom and direction from the John Hopkins team, who encouraged us by saying they wanted to go for a cure.

It also included the amazing team from Believe Big, with their helpful, encouraging, practical, and hope-filled resources. These resources connected me to an integrative practitioner who developed a tailor-made comprehensive protocol for my healing. Along with traditional medical and integrative treatments, I've included consistent exercise in my weekly rhythms and received invaluable prayer support.

As of today, my PSA has been undetectable for the last five quarters, and I feel healthier and stronger than ever before. Words can't express how thankful I am for my entire care and support team, my whole family, and particularly my wife, Laura, who has walked every step of the way with me on this journey.

The caregivers are the heroes. One incredible resource is a book called Radical Hope. In that book, there's research on thousands of people who have gone into remission, and there are ten practices each of them had been doing, one of them being a reason to live.

So I conclude by sharing a picture of my family, all 20 of us after my 33rd round of treatments of radiation in my pelvic area. It was the only day all year long that all of them could have been together on December 29th to help me ring the bell.

Two years ago, in the quiet hours of the night, I found myself at a crossroads. Diagnosed with stage III colon cancer, conventional treatments were not an option due to my compromised immune system. As I scoured the internet, I stumbled upon stories of resilience and triumph shared by fellow cancer survivors. Their courage ignited a spark within me, a determination to overcome. I made a promise to myself and to those around me that I would stand before them one day, sharing my own story of victory.

So there I sat at my kitchen table, having just undergone surgery to remove a significant portion of my colon and over 60 lymph nodes. But I was determined, driven by a fierce resolve to beat this disease.



Helixor Conference in Ecuador

Believe Big was invited to be a part of the Integrative Medicine Meeting in Quito, Ecuador! We joined physicians from all over South America learning the latest research and practices of mistletoe and other complementary therapies. Dr. Paller from Johns Hopkins participated remotely and shared the research results of the mistletoe trial and other natural product trials she investigated. Ivelisse shared her story and for the first time in Spanish!



Trial Published

The Phase I Trial of Intravenous Mistletoe in collaboration with Johns Hopkins School of Medicine was published! The conclusions from the trial deemed that Mistletoe improved a patient's quality of life and is safe. The recommended Mistletoe dosage was also determined via the trial.
